Year 3

Year 5

Listen attentively and understand more complex phrases and sentences.

Understand the main points from a short spoken passage made up of familiar language.

Follow instructions and directions

Understand higher numbers (confidently up to 50 and be familiar with numbers up to 100).

Recognise letters of the alphabet when they hear them.

Year 6

Understand and respond to spoken language from a variety of sources e.g. song, story, passage

Understand more complex phrases or sentences e.g. descriptions, information, instructions

Understand numbers in context

Listen to short passages and identify key points and some detail.
