Subject: French **Strand: Writing**

National Curriculum PoS:

Write phrases from memory, and adapt these to create new sentences, to express ideas clearly.

Describe people, places, things and actions orally and in writing.

Year 3

Write some simple familiar words from memory.

Write one or two simple sentences using a model.

Label an animal e.g. a black cat.

Complete a simple cloze procedure.



Year 4

Write a short text using a model.

Write a few simple sentences from memory.

Use word banks to support when writing.

Begin to use pronouns e.g. to write about a celebrity.



Year 5

Write three or four sentences using a model / word bank linked to a recent area of learning.

Use simple conjunctions such as and, but because to form longer sentences.

Change elements in a given text.

Use a bi-lingual dictionary to support spelling.

Attempt to write two or three sentences from memory.



Year 6

Write sentences and construct short texts using a model.

Write a few sentences from memory.

Use adjectives to add interest.

Writing reflects understanding of gender of nouns, plural, word order, agreement of high frequency adjectives.
