Subject: History Strand: Change and Continuity

Year 3

- Use evidence to find out how things changed during a time period (eg. houses and settlements, culture and the way of life, people's beliefs and attitudes and differences between rich and poor)
- Suggest reasons for why there were differences between time periods



Year 4

- Describe changes during time periods studied –
- Describe some similarities and differences between different time periods
- Describe the impact of a significant historical figure on life in Britain



Year 5

- Identify changes and links within and across the time periods studied, within Britain and the wider world
- Give own reasons why changes may have occurred, backed up by evidence



Year 6

- Identify how aspects of life have changed during a time period and give reasons why backing it up with evidence and statistics.
- Describe how some changes impact both on subsequent periods, and, in the long term, on today's society
