retell	Tell the story in your own words.
predict	Guess what is going to happen.
adjective	A word used to describe a noun.

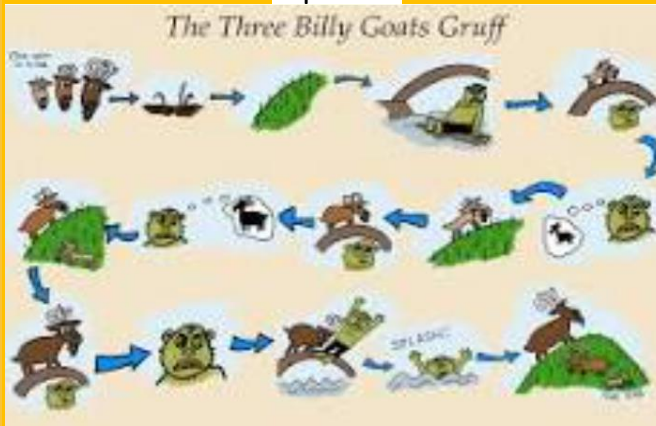
What I should already know:

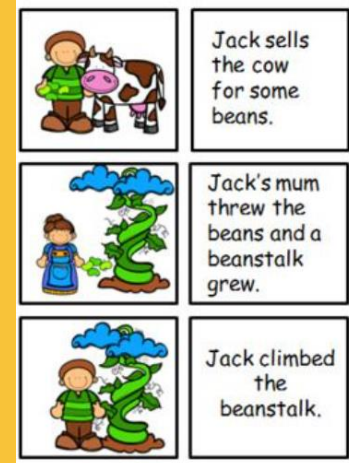
