

Fairy Tale Authors:

Author	Facts
The Brothers Grimm	Jacob and Wilhelm were born in Germany. They wrote over 200 fairytales. Some of their stories included 'Rapunzel', 'Hansel and Gretel' and 'Cinderella'.
Hans Christian Andersen	He was born in Denmark and wrote 160 fairy tales. Including 'The Snow Queen' and 'The Ugly Duckling'.
Charles Perrault	He was born in France. He published a book of fairytales, including publishing 'Puss in Boots'.
