#### Prove It:

The children will become Viking's! They will describe exactly what life as a Viking was like. They must include various aspects of a Viking's life, from what they eat and drink to how they fight in battle. **Showcase:**

#### History:

#### <u>RE:</u>

Rituals (water). We will describe the meaning of rituals and the value of these to Christians. We will share our thoughts on rituals with water and how this applies to our lives.

#### PSHE:

Being Me In My World: We will be learning about how to make others feel welcome, thinking about how everyone has the right to learn and caring about others and their feelings.

# Things to explore with your child!

#### PE:

### Home Learning:

Maths, Reading and SPaG home learning tasks will be set using Teams. We use *Times Tables Rockstars* to practice our times tables. Please aim for your child to do these at least 3 times a week.

Home learning is given out every Thursday and is due in on a Tuesday.

#### **Reading:**

We encourage you to listen to your child read at least once a week and write in their reading record, which will be made digital on Teams through 'Class Notebook'. Ideally they should read every evening, making sure they read a variety of different genres. This could be for as little as 5 minutes.

#### Maths:

Encourage your child to practise their times tables daily as these underpin all other aspects of maths (ask them to teach you some of the games they have learnt at school for this).

Try to think of everyday opportunities when you can talk about maths to your child – for example, telling the time or adding up totals when you are out shopping.

#### Science:

Discuss with your child how different sounds are made. Can you find examples around the house?

When out and about, what sounds do you hear? How far away are they and do they change as you get closer?

#### Writing:

Over this half term we will be looking at Viking legends.

Discuss with your child: What myths and legends do you know? What do they have in common? Who is the hero in the story?

If possible, visit your local library and find some myths and legends to read together.
