Year 4 Topics:
A topic overview is sent out at the start of each half term to parents and carers.

Year 4 Maths:

- Working with numbers up to 1,000
- More complex fraction objectives (e.g. equivalent fractions and recognising decimal equivalent)
- Multiplying by 2 and 3 digit numbers
- Multiplying and dividing by 10,100
- Use place value to mentally multiply and divide

It is the expectation that by the end of Year 4, children should know all of the times tables up to $12 x 12$ - multiplication underpins a lot of the objectives in the maths curriculum.

Year 4 Multiplication table check:
It is the expectation that by the end of Year 4, children should know all of the times tables up to $12 x 12$ - multiplication underpins a lot of the abjectives in the maths curxiculum.

In June children will complete a mandatory Government check that will test their times table ability.

Lots of practise will be done at school to prepare for this. TT - Rockstars is strongly encouraged to be used to support this at home.

- All children have a laptop allocated to them in class

Home Learning:
