Phonics

- All Aboard Phonics scheme
- Phonics every day
 - + Voicing phonemes
 - + Segmenting
 - + Blending
 - + Phonics vocabulary
- Phonics screening in June at the end of Year 1.
- Pass mark is 32/40 – this data is used to target Y2 interventions to ensure each child is reading fluently by the end of the key stage.

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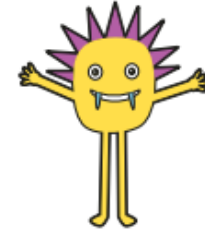
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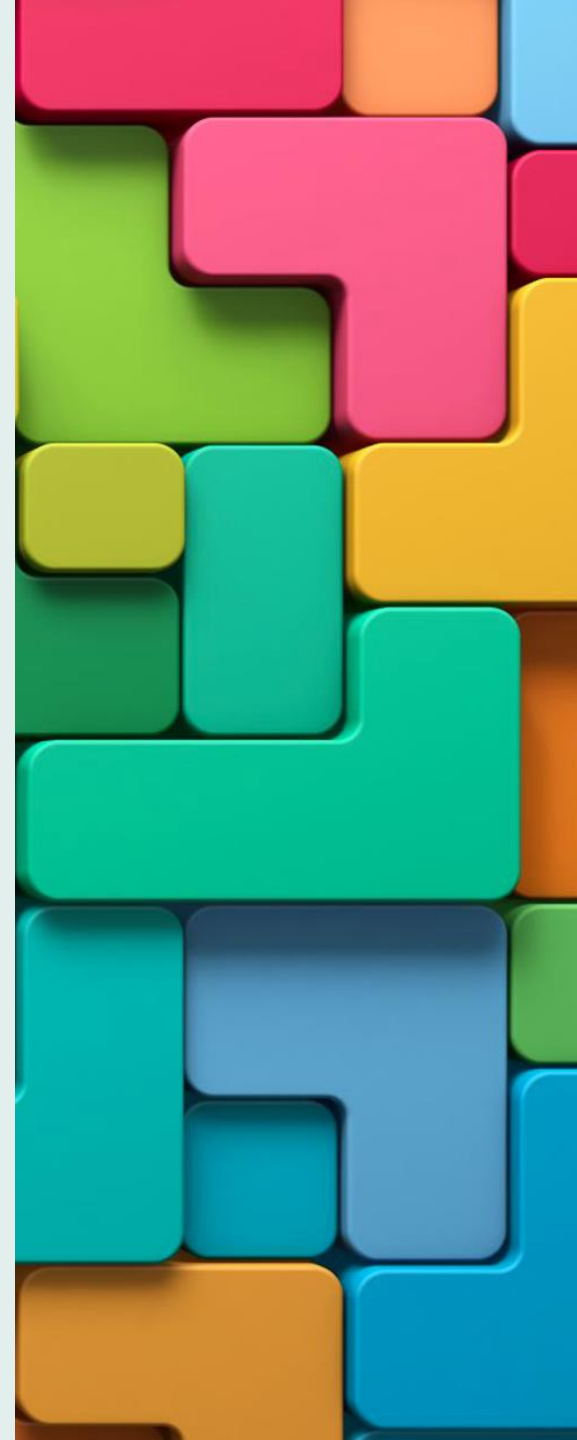


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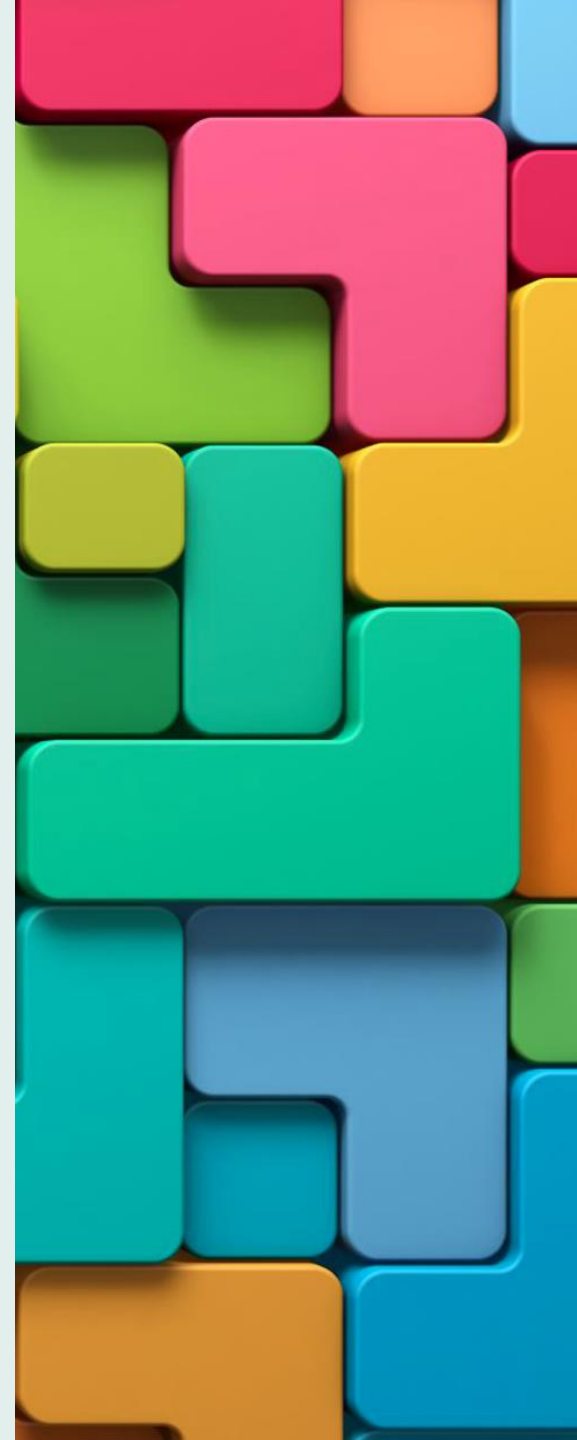
Reading at home

- We ask children to read three times at home with an adult writing in their reading record.
- Regular readers get stickers and praise in school.
- Top 5 tips for reading at home:
 - + All Aboard app
 - + Praise – 5 for each correction
 - + Decode, decode, decode
 - + Text size
 - + Magic reread in 10-15 minutes of reading
- Reading books will be changed at school each week by Thursday.
- Children are all heard reading at school each week.



Home Learning

- Spellings will be sent home weekly – please practice them daily.
- Reading 3 x a week
- Home Learning Projects each half term.



PE days and uniform

- Turtle class PE is on Monday and Thursdays.
- Angelfish class PE is on Tuesday and Thursdays
