



Year 1

Term: Summer 2

Spoken Language:

We are using spoken language to build our vocabulary, thinking about different nouns (e.g. bricks, building) and adjectives (e.g. wide, pointy) we could use when describing buildings.

Writing:

We are writing a recount of our walk around Fratton and a leaflet about the local area.

Engage:

To start our topic, the children will complete a variety of activities to familiarise themselves with landmarks around Portsmouth.

Prove It:

Children will show what they have learnt about the city of Portsmouth and prove that it is a city.

Maths:

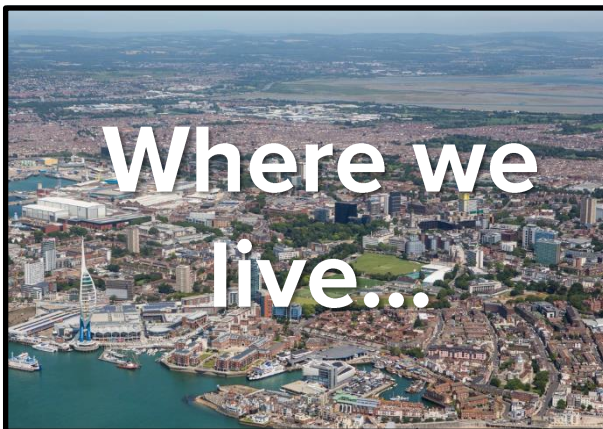
We are starting the half term by learning about money. After that, the children will be learning about fractions of a group of objects.

PE:

Our PE unit this half term focuses on 'athletics', building upon the children's running and hurdling skills.

Science:

We will learn about the four seasons and how these might look different. We look at how the weather and day length changes throughout the year, as well as which months are in which season.



RE:

We explore the concept of 'creation' in the context of the Christian religion.

PSHE:

Our PSHE unit this term is called 'Changing Me' where we learn about the life cycles of animals and humans.

Art:

In art, we will look at the artwork of Andy Warhol. We will experiment with mixing primary colours and use different brushes to paint.

Geography:

In geography, we will explore the differences between city and countryside, name the four countries that make up the United Kingdom and identify key features of our local area.

Music:

The children will learn to feel the pulse and rhythm of music.

Computing:

We will begin to learn about coding (entering instructions for a computer program to follow) using 'Scratch' on the iPads.

Things to explore with your child!

Home Learning:

Spellings will be sent home to
practise.

Reading:

Our expectation is that every
child reads 3 times a week at
home. Please use the reading
diary to record your reading.

They will also read with an adult
in school at least once a week.

Encourage your child to
complete the Penbridge
Reading Challenge.

Writing:

Look at some leaflets together.
What information has been
included?

Encourage your child to
verbally recount what has
happened during the day, with a
focus on description and what
they found interesting.

Maths:

Practise adding one digit numbers
to numbers up to 100 e.g. $62+5$.

Practise forming numbers
correctly, making sure they are not
backwards.

Practise adding numbers up to 20,
making number bonds.

Science:

What signs of spring/summer
can you see?

Talk about how the days are
getting longer and the weather
is changing.
